

# Batting Cage Rules

First time users must undergo a brief equipment orientation with Fieldhouse staff.

You must be 15 or older to feed the pitching machines.

Youth under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.

Adults are responsible for the conduct of the youths in the batting cage. Misconduct will result in immediate termination of privileges.

You must wear closed-toed shoes in the batting cage.

No cleats allowed.

No food or drink in the batting cage.

Batters and feeders must wear helmets at all times while in the batting cage.

Always stand behind the safety net when operating the pitching machines.

Spectators and those not batting must stand outside the netted area.

Please take practice pitches before inviting the batter into the cage. Adjustments to speed will greatly alter the flight path of the ball. NO adjustments should be made once the batter has entered the cage.

Do not swing bats outside of the cage.

Once your time is up, please stop the machine and return the balls to the bucket.

**FEE MUST BE PAID AND A WAIVER SIGNED BEFORE USING THE BATTING CAGES. IF THE PARTICIPANTS ARE UNDER 18, A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST SIGN THE WAIVER FORM.**
