



Guidelines for Indoor Pickleball

Updated October 8, 2020*

Scheduling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Games will be played to 11 and teams must win by 2.• If large groups are waiting to play, the Pickleball supervisor may invoke the rally scoring system, have games played to 11, must win by 1, or reduce the game to 9 points.• All participants must immediately leave the facility at conclusion of the drop in sessions.
Facility Entrance & Warm Up Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Players must immediately leave the facility after the completion of their session.• Use every second court where practical.
Player Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Players must clean all trash and personal items from all areas.• Benches are not available.• Players <i>and their equipment</i> must remain 6 feet apart on the sidelines, when waiting their turn, or observing play in and around the court areas.• Social gatherings and congregations within the facility are not permitted.
Player Limitations	<p>All participants must self-screen for a temperature of 100.4 or higher and any other COVID symptoms and are NOT allowed to attend if exhibiting either.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single play is strongly encouraged.• Depending upon the amount of players waiting their turn, Doubles play will be allowed. The same group of four players plays only with each other.• At the conclusion of your game, rotation off the court will be required when individuals or groups are waiting their turn.
Food and Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Players must bring their own water/sports drink. Water fountains are not available.• Wash hands before attending and bring your own personal sanitizer when possible. Players are encouraged to sanitize their hands regularly.
Personal Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Players will label a personal ball that ONLY they will touch during play. (Practice caution with the balls and avoid letting the participants touch them.) Pickleballs should be cleaned between use.• Errant balls will be returned to the owner of the ball via foot or racquet push of the ball.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wearing a glove on the non-serving hand to retrieve a loose ball is acceptable and sanitizing of the glove is required prior to each game.
Shared Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal equipment is strongly encouraged. • If a house ball is used, then the sanitation of the pickleballs will be required prior to and after the conclusion of each game. • Paddles obtained from the front desk have been sanitized from the previous day, however they are to be cleaned prior to use as well as at the conclusion of your participation. • Cleaning supplies will be provided. • Those setting up and breaking down the netting system are asked to sanitize the poles prior to and at the conclusion of play. Netting systems that are set up by staff will be sanitized prior to usage.
Social Distancing-Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain 6 feet apart during warm ups, stretching and at all times. • No handshakes, racquet bumps or physical contact between players. • Please do not handle others equipment. • Sportsmanship will continue to be a touchless manner.
Spectators	<p>See the Sport Leagues Guidelines for overall spectator information and requirements. The following is specific to Pickleball.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No spectators are allowed on the court to allow for player spacing. •
Coaches	<i>Adult: NA</i>
Game Staff Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be considerate to staff if they feel it is necessary to address a situation with participants concerning violation of stated rules. • Those that refuse compliance will be asked to leave the premises and may be subject to loss of future privileges.
